Up to the present both police and the merchants of the city have worked together in providing both victuals and money for the relief of the hundreds of men who have literally taken the city by storm during the past six weeks.

F. Wilson, the leader of yesterday's band, stated that 400 more equally destitute and needy working men were on their way to the city. It appears to be time that the council provided the means for affording them help.

San Francisco boasts of a number of soup kitchens in addition to the recently built Salvation Army shelter, which alone feeds hundreds weekly. Should the merchants of this city become weary of the continual calls made upon them and refuse the food demanded by the starving crowds at present on the road to this city, nothing could prevent a most dangerous condition of affairs.

Hungry men must eat, and if the means are denied them in one way they will obtain them in another. So far the men have been orderly in their behavior, and when provided with food, the only thing they ask for, have left the town within a short time after their arrival.

The safety of the city's inhabitants demands that the authorities should provide the means to enable this peaceful condition of affairs to last. The crowds will continue to come probably all winter, and will have to be fed. It is not just that private citizens should continue to bear the whole burden of providing for them.

A soup kitchen or relief station of some description should be at once provided by the city; the cost would be light and would add considerably to the security of the residents in outlying portions of the city.
