A Revolution Pending in Process of Canning Fruit

A New German Process by Which Glass is to be Substituted for the Omnipresent Tin Can

The California Trade Review says that a combination has been formed by the retailers and dealers in coal at San Francisco for the purpose of increasing the price of that commodity.

A very important improvement, says the Grocery World, has just been made in the American canning industry, and it is expected to revolutionize the trade throughout the entire country.

This, in itself would mean a great deal to this country, as every year we import nearly \$4,000,000 worth of tin plate from abroad.

The concern which has purchased the patent for this country uses 3,000,000 tin cans annually, and this season proposes to do away with them entirely.
