PASADENA, Jan. 4.—Announcement is made tonight that Dr. Medici de Biron, the active agent for the Humane society, who has been quietly investigating the milk supply of the city, found the deadly formaldehyde in three bottles taken from milk wagons yesterday. Careful chemical tests were made today and in each one of the bottles there was found the poisonous preservative. One contained sufficient to injure seriously a weak or sickly baby or little child. Today a number of samples were taken from other dealers about the city and further tests will follow. Tonight it is stated by Dr. de Biron that the whole matter has been placed in the hands of the city attorney and Mayor Vedder. Arrests are expected tomorrow. The humane officer also makes complaint that many of the milk dealers are not making the tubercular tests, as required by the ordinance. The whole matter will be looked into by the city authorities at once.

Ranchers Fear Municipal Water. While the local orange and fruit growers do not necessarily oppose the idea of municipal ownership of water, still there has been considerable questioning over the probable treatment of the ranchers by the city in the matter of irrigating water, and a call has been issued by C. A. Day, the prominent fruit grower and horticulture commissioner for this county, for a general meeting to be held tomorrow night at 7:30 in the board of trade rooms. In explaining his personal position Mr. Day says that if he should not be allowed for irrigation under the city ownership as much water as under the old companies, then he must necessarily cut up his large ranch into town lots. Many others would have to do this same thing, and it would very shortly put a stop to the prosperous orange industry in this locality.
