

PRICE DECLINE HAS REACHED THE LIMIT

Amalgamated Copper in Demand and Eric Securities Firm—All Speculative Accounts Cleared

Up by Reaction

SHARP ADVANCE IN PRICES; STANDARD STOCKS ACTIVE

Higher prices prevailed at the opening of the stock market yesterday. Northwestern opened 3/4 points higher, and Amalgamated Copper was active at 72.

Activity centered in the railroads, the especially Union Pacific and St. Paul, which sold above \$118 and \$174, respectively.

When Reading advanced 2 points prices were lifted again to a higher plane all around.

The tone of the foreign markets was cheerfully optimistic to the opening of the market.

Prices of Americans were up in London before the opening here and buying for foreign account followed when our market opened.

With the gathering force of the upward movement stocks became fairly buoyant and inclined to lag apparently from dissatisfaction at its non-speculative accounts by yesterday's sharp reaction normally benefited the technical situation of the market.

Rates for time money further hardened to some extent, which is the only effect perceptible from the continued large demand for our gold.
