FARMERS REJOICING: PROSPECTS UNUSUALLY BRIGHT

Crop Bulletin Indicates a General Feeling of Prosperity Throughout Southern California—Little Damage From Frost

Farmers are happy, according to George E. Franklin, the weather forecaster. The official bulletin just issued says: The very cold weather which prevailed at the close of last week's bulletin...

The soil has not been so thoroughly soaked for years, and generally farm work and orange shipping are at a standstill on account of the ground and orchards being too wet for work.

Santa Barbara County

Santa Barbara—1.95 inches rain fell February 16-17, making 21.02 inches for the season. The weather has been mild and calm; the wind storms which prevailed elsewhere did not reach here.

Santa Bernardino County

Santa Bernardino—1.59 inches rain fell during the week, making 11.93 inches for the season. The cold weather on February 13 did not injure citrus fruits or trees; tender vegetables and young growth were nipped by frost.

Ventura County

Ventura—The frost of February 13 did no damage to citrus fruits; 2.75 inches rain fell February 15-17, making 18.21 inches for the season. The rains made the rivers unfordable. Several cars of oranges being shipped, notwithstanding wet weather.
