

FAVORITE STOCKS RISE TO A HIGH LEVEL

ACTIVITY DUE TO RUMORS Union Pacific, St. Paul, New York Central and Northern Securities the Leaders—Industrials Are Taken by Traders

LEADING SECURITIES IN ACTIVE DEMAND

At the opening of the stock market yesterday leading and Union Pacific rose to a point, New York Central sold at \$1.60, Union Pacific rose to \$1.85 and Reading touched 98c.

The more notable advances were Woolen, 4; Northwestern preferred, 1; Lead, 1/2; and Car. Distillers Securities, Linseed Oil, Smelting, General Electric and Baltimore & Ohio 1/2.

Illinois Central was pushed up points to above the previous high level. St. Paul was lifted 5/8 and the preferred 3; Rock Island, an enormous absorption got up only a fraction.

The last named stock bounded up to the neighborhood of \$1.80, thus justifying predictions which have been current among street speculative operators for some time, but without obtaining general credence.

As a large proportion of this distribution was made to the Union Pacific, that stock was held to be entitled to a corresponding advance, but with the excitement started in the market this explanation was deemed inadequate and surmise fell back upon the supposed news to which the Union Pacific preferred stock is to be put.
