STARTLING STATEMENT MADE BY CRUSADERS

SAY WOMEN ARE DEBAUCHED

Resolutions Denouncing Violations of Law Are Passed and Will Be Presented to Mayor and Police Commissioners

At a meeting held at the Nazarene church last night more than 1000 persons voted on a resolution calling the attention of the mayor and police commissioners to the alleged disregard of the liquor laws by the proprietors of restaurants in Los Angeles.

"WHEREAS, IT HAS BEEN MADE KNOWN THAT CERTAIN RESTAURANTS AND CAFES IN LOS ANGELES HAVE FLAGRANTLY VIOLATED THE LAW BY SELLING LIQUOR TO WOMEN AND GIRLS, APPARENTLY WITHOUT LET OR HINDERANCE, AND ARE DEBAUCHING OUR YOUTH IN A SHAMEFUL MANNER AND BRINGING DISGRACE ON OUR CITY'S FAIR NAME AND DEEP SORROW TO MANY OF ITS HOMES, THEREFORE BE IT

"RESOLVED, THAT WE RESPECTFULLY BUT EARNESTLY CALL UPON THE MAYOR AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS TO REVOKE THE LICENSES OF ALL SUCH RESTAURANTS AND CAFES AND BRING THE VIOLATORS TO SPEEDY JUSTICE."

THIS RESOLUTION WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE MAYOR TUESDAY AND THE STATEMENT WAS MADE AT LAST NIGHT'S MEETING THAT SHOULD THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE DISREGARD THIS PETITION STEPS TOWARDS A RECALL WOULD BE TAKEN.

THE SHOOTING OCCURRED IN A HOUSE IN PELL STREET, SAID TO BE THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE ON LEONG TONG. WHEN THE POLICE, ATTRACTED BY THE SOUND OF FIRING, ARRIVED THEY FOUND IN THE HOUSE 200 CHINESE, FOUR OF WHOM WERE WOUNDED.
