

FORMAL CHARGES AGAINST MAYOR PASADENA CITIZENS PREPARE RECALL PETITION

Councilmen Crandall and Dyer Said to Be on Waiting List—Administration to Confer With Water Companies

PASADENA, Jan. 19.—The executive committee of 100 in charge of the proposed recall proceedings against Mayor William Waterhouse will meet tomorrow evening to determine whether or not any of the city councilmen are to be recalled at this time on account of their position on the water question.

At last night's meeting of the committee of five the membership of the recall committee originally fixed at fifty was raised to 100, and the matter above referred to and the choice of a permanent secretary and permanent quarters turned over to this committee for decision on Saturday night.

EAGLES FLY AT UPLAND San Bernardino Sends Delegation to the Banquet of the Upland Aerie


