Weather Conditions

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 22.—Weather conditions and general forecast: Generally cloudy weather prevails over the Pacific coast and the showers have occurred in all sections. The pressure has risen rapidly over the western portion of the country during the past twenty-four hours, but there has been a slight fall on the Northern California and Southern Oregon coast during the last twenty-four hours and the wind in this section has changed to southeast, which would indicate strengthening weather and probably showers in the northern portion of California Friday.
