WOMAN SAYS CUPID WAS BAD

INSTANT DEATH OR SUDDEN MARRIAGE HIS DECREE

Young and Pretty Bride Sues for Divorce on the Ground That Her Promise to Wed Was Secured by Threats

Alleging that she was compelled to take part in the marriage ceremony under threat of instant death if she refused, Mrs. Caroline C. Smedley yesterday filed suit for annulment of marriage in the superior court, naming her husband, J. Frank Smedley, as defendant to the remarkable allegation.

Mrs. Smedley states in her complaint that she arrived in Los Angeles from Chester, Pa., January 14 last, that she had been in ill-health because of lung trouble up to that time, and that she had come west in the hope of benefiting her health.

Upon her arrival she went to a boarding house conducted by J. Frank Smedley's mother. After a few days she left the house and attended to some business and upon her return the son was waiting to see her.

Smedley is smitten. It must have been love at first sight, according to the allegations of the girl, for she states in her complaint that within two days after their first meeting Smedley proposed to her, and when she told him that she did not want to marry him and did not care for him she alleges that he said he would kill her if she refused to become his wife, and from that time on importuned and threatened her.

She refused until January 29, when she married him, and eight days later she deserted him and filed proceedings for annulment of marriage.

Mrs. Smedley alleges that she was forced to marry Smedley in fear of his threats, that she objected to getting the license and objected to the ceremony, and that she does not love the man. She is twenty-two years of age and pretty.
