MONEY DEMANDS COME IN BUNCHES DEFENDANT'S WEAKEST PROTESTS ARE UNAVAILING

Judge Piles One Order on Another with a Nonchalance That Makes Victim Gasp for Breath If ever a man received just a little more than he expected, and if ever the surprise was unpleasant, that surprise was given Elmer E. King yesterday afternoon before Judge Hutton in department seven of the superior court, when King appeared to show cause why he should not be called upon to pay attorney's fees and other expenses in his wife's suit for divorce against him.

Protests Are Unavailing Immediately thereafter King sold some property which his wife alleged was community property and therefor part hers. The new owner of the property promptly brought suit against Mrs. King's contention on the ground that King in turn had her husband appear before Judge Hutton yesterday afternoon to furnish the necessary cash for her to defend the quiet title suit.

King did not seem to be suffering with good humor when he made his appearance. The judge first ruled that he pay the sum of \$25 for incidental expense of the suit. "But, your honor," began King, "I cannot pay that." "And \$5 a week for the maintenance of the little boy," said Judge Hutton, apparently unmoved. "Oh-h-h," said King. "And \$5 a week for the care of Mrs. King," interjected the judge. "Eh-h-h-h?" said King, with facial accompaniment. "And \$50 for attorney's fees, to be paid at once; no, make it \$75," said the judge. "Ah-h-h-h," said King in a sad, far away sounding voice. "To be paid at once," said Judge Hutton, and the bailiff brought the defendant a glass of lemonade. The divorce troubles in which King is charged with cruelty are dated to be heard early in April.
