GOOD FRIDAY OBSERVED IN CATHOLIC CHURCHES
Yesterday, Good Friday, was observed in the Catholic and Episcopal churches, and special services were held in many of the Protestant churches. At St. Vibiana's cathedral, as in all the Catholic churches, mass of the pre-sanctified was celebrated.
