



FILL UP HOLES IS THE ORDER

CITY INSPECTORS WILL WATCH TAMPING PROCESS No More Ridges Over Excavations Will Be Permitted, as They Interfere with the Flushing Machines

New orders were issued yesterday by the bureau of street maintenance and inspection in order to permit of the easy operation of the new street flushing machines without damage to the pavements.

The order of D. K. Edwards, inspector of public works, is as follows: "To inspectors and others having charge of excavations: "The flushing of our paved streets will require some reform in the way of handling excavations. Dirt ridges over excavations will not be permitted.



"Have the asphalt and concrete taken out and placed on one side and the dirt on the other. When pipe is laid or repair work finished see that all dirt is replaced in the trench and well compacted, either by using water or thoroughly tamping, or both. This can be done, and the ordinance requires it, except in case of very large pipes or conduits. Then put in the old concrete well broken and tamped. After this replace the asphalt slabs flush with the street surface. See that the workmen
