STOCKS SELL WITH RUSH

ACTIVE MOVEMENT NOTED ON NEW YORK EXCHANGE

PRICES LOW—MUCH UNEASINESS IS FELT

Wall Street Men Inclined to Believe Government Will Begin General Prosecution of the Big Corporations

NEW YORK, Aug. 6.—The dealings in stocks by noon today had passed the figure of the aggregate sales for the whole of yesterday. A weak and unsettled market and an active selling movement furnished the explanation of the increase in animation of dealings.

There were various features in the day's news which were given responsibility for the increased speculative sentiment. More direct interest was shown in the immediate vicinity of the stock exchange in the identity of large sellers of securities, combining to give a clew to the motives as to the standing and influence of the sellers. No definite success was achieved in the endeavor to solve the mystery which the active parties in the operation that attracted curiosity would, of course, use every device to conceal.

That there was no important buying was a pertinent fact for some time. The aggressive or urgent selling which developed late in yesterday's market continued over today was a new feature of the market and gave occasion for anxiety upon the part of bidders of stocks on margins.

Newly returned tourists from abroad, where important financial missions were supposed to be an object, were subjected to gossip and connected with the market. A number of last week's late arrivals of this element are in the front ranks of capitalists and are supposed to be also active in stock market operations.

Conferees were alleged to have occurred with bankers and other interests at which the financial situation was discussed and which has been followed by the selling movement in the stock market. The Standard Oil line is regarded as a forerunner of other suits against various corporations which will be promoted by the example of that case.

Possible prosecution against the railroad officials concerned in that case was discussed. The series of measures directed against railroads in a group of southern states, fed the apprehension felt by market operators upon the subject of further decrease in the price of copper in London and at the New York metal exchange was a factor in the weakness. So was the engagement of \$500,000 in gold for shipment to London.

The continent of Europe was an active bidder for gold in the London market also and \$2,000,000 of gold was available against the \$500,000 secured at the Bank of England. Private discounts rose in London. The weekly bulletin of the weather bureau was not regarded as entirely satisfactory as to the crop conditions in part of the wheat belt and for the cotton belt. Rates for time money continued to advance, but foreign and out-town bankers. The shorts took profit before the day was over and worked a substantial rally, but it was all lost again and the market closed weak.
