WASHINGTON, July 25.—A dispatch received by the navy department today from the gunboat Yorktown, on sealing patrol duty about the Pribiloff islands, Alaska, indicates that while the situation in sealing waters at present is quiet, five Japanese schooners are sealing near the island of St. Paul. ### COUNTY DEMOCRATIC OFFICERS GIVE OUT LIST

Apportionment for Each Precinct Shown in Call, Subject to Approval by Convention on August 20

Delegates to the coming county Democratic convention at Los Angeles Turner hall on recommendation of their credentials committee will on August 20 settle for themselves what the official apportionment will be.

The revised call allows for 635 delegates, but this number is not in accord with the earlier call which was filed with the board of county supervisors, though never printed or sent out because of errors in figuring. To prevent possible irregularity the convention will settle representation, Chairman Anthony Schwamm having decided to make formal announcement that discrepancies in figuring crept into the first call.
