HEARST READS, CROWD LEAVES

AUDITORIUM IS EMPTIED AT SIGHT OF COPY

AUDIENCE LARGELY COMPOSED OF WOMEN AND YOUTHS

Hisgen Denounces Bryan, Lauds Doodle Dee Leader and Declares Country in Need of Another Party

It was not a stampee; it was a panic. The crowd of curiosity seekers that filled the Shriners' auditorium last night to get a look at William Randolph Hearst came, saw, turned round and marched right out again.

Hearst did not speak first, hence the curious ones perforce remained.

Thomas Hisgen, presidential candidate of the Doodle Dees, was the first number.

The moment Hisgen concluded and Hearst made his bow there was a stampee. Several hundred crowded into the aisles to get a look at the speaker and then started an exodus. They had come to see, not to hear, Hearst, and having feasted their eyes and satisfied their curiosity were content to start homeward. They swamped the twenty-three trolley cars in waiting outside.

Reads His "Speech"

Hearst read his typewritten "speech," that had been prepared for him by his salaried writers, and did so with few errors.

The back of the tenth row could not hear a word of the ready-made utterances, and the clatter of the outgoing throng made the task of the speaker and his irksome, disheartening and torturing.

The auditorium was filled at the outset. For days handbills and cards had been industriously distributed by advance agents. Hands played lustily outside the big structure last night to attract the wayfarers and by dint of much press agency a big gathering was induced to file into the spacious auditorium. Two-thirds of the crowd represented women and young people and the other third consisted of voters.

The audience fretted somewhat when Mr. Hisgen was brought forward first, but listened resignedly.

Hisgen Glad He's Here

Mr. Hisgen in the course of his address said: "This is my first visit to the great state of California. I have dreamed of coming here all my life. I think every other man and woman who lives in other states of the Union has had the same dream."

"It is a wonderful state and its fame has circled the globe. The great disaster that befell San Francisco showed how the love of the nation with the two that stricken cities of the Pacific slope. "In addition to the business enterprise of the residents of this section of the country they are famed abroad for their independence and their demand for honesty and justice in the high places of the land."

"It is to discuss questions of government in connection with the two old parties that I have come all the way from my far-off home in Massachusetts to your hospitable shores. "I am the candidate of the Independent party for president of the United States—the first national candidate of the new party. And I want to say that among the delegates to Chicago were those from this state. I wish to thank those delegates at this first opportunity I have had in their home state."

"I have learned many things since I began my campaign. I have learned for one thing, and to me that is a very important thing, that there is a general agreement that there is a necessity for a new party in this country. "The remainder of the speech was a laudation of Hearst and a denunciation of Bryan."

The Big Show

Then came the big show—Hearst himself. What he said was mostly a raking over of Tom Taggart.

When it was all over a crowd in the galleries cheered for Bryan, and the shouts were taken up all over the hall. There was a handshaking soiree afterward, and everyone who wanted to do so greeted the candidate and his sponsor.

Joseph Simons also grasped Hearst's hands, remarking: "This ain't like in St. Louis four years ago, when you had me on the committee to keep Tom Taggart in line for you, is it?"

And Hearst turned his face away.

These two questions, formally addressed to Mr. Hearst by H. Cass Caldwell, were totally ignored by the speaker.

"Is it not a fact that the San Francisco Examiner (and through it, its owner) is more responsible for the election of Eugene Schmitz as mayor of San Francisco than any other party or person?"

"How is it that you are so friendly with President Taft when it is he who is but a short time since that he said of you and your papers that you were more responsible than all else for the death of William McKinley?"

ACCUSED OF TAKING WELLS-FARGO'S CASH

SAN BERNARDINO, Oct. 5.—F. E. Trapp, night operator and express agent at Ludlow, is under arrest at Daggett, charged with stealing \$300 in cash which had been shipped by Wells-Fargo express from that station Sunday night. He forged the name of the train agent to the receipt book, and the name of the Needles operator to a wire pass for Los Angeles. He neglected, however, to remove the bill from the package of bills, and when the package was checked up his express matter he found himself short the \$300 package of cash. He wired Trapp, but, getting no reply, telegraphed the officials at Needles.

They soon ascertained that Trapp had boarded the westbound overland and caused his arrest at Daggett. His suitcase was taken out at Barstow, and on being opened, the money was found there.

Before leaving Trapp left a note addressed to the day operator at Ludlow, Collins, thanking him for the use of his typewriter, and a similar note to Agent Lanning, telling him life was too short to spend on the desert. He committed the theft the first night he worked at Ludlow, having just been assigned to that station. In Trapp's grip were found circulars sent out by the sheriff of Santa Clara county giving his description and asking his arrest for embezzlement in that county.

PROSECUTOR IS SHORN OF POWER

grand jury felt much irritation over the published statement that it would take a trip to the Whittier reform school, because anticipation of such a visit caused a rapid overturning and readjustment of the meal system and other methods at that institution. The grand jury is thought at the courthouse to have important plans for sounding channels in which graft is thought to be found at the bottom, and the talk about the "Whittier trip is said to have made bad fishing in that regard."

A rumor that the grand jury had talked plainly to Capt. Fredericks about this, and that the graft matter might be placed in the hands of outside counsel for prosecution, was strengthened by a conference yesterday afternoon between members of the jury and Walter Bordwell, who is acting as presiding judge in the absence of W. P. James.

Shortly before noon A. E. Pomeroy, temporary chairman of the grand jury, and Miles S. Gregory, its secretary, came out of the jury room and entered Judge Bordwell's chambers. At 2:30 o'clock almost the entire membership of the grand jury went into Judge Bordwell's office, remaining half an hour.

Fifteen minutes after the grand jury's afternoon session was called the district attorney was again sent for and he remained in the jury room an hour. No one but Fredericks and Woolwine were called before the grand jury yesterday. The jury took an adjournment yesterday afternoon, soon after Capt. Fredericks left, until Wednesday morning.

The daily official putting of heads together over Woolwine at the city hall occurred yesterday afternoon at 6:30 o'clock, when Mayor Harper, the members of the police commission, Chief of Police Edward Kern and Police Captain Thomas Broadhead met in the mayor's inner office. It is understood that they discussed the possibility of appearing before the grand jury and the advisability of firing a public broadside on the graft question after the police commissioners' meeting this afternoon.
