Spitting fire and smoke and sputtering like an exaggerated gaiting gun, Freddie Huyuck's machine turned the Ascot park oval yesterday afternoon in 53 seconds for the five-mile race, one second faster than the world's record of 54 seconds that he already held.

With a standing start he made the first mile in ten and a half, which is the other world's record, and when the time was figured up for five miles he had another to his credit in the time of 4:33.
