

'NICK' OSWALD HIDING OFFICERS UNABLE TO FIND MISSING WITNESS

MEETING OF JURORS MAY BE DELAYED

After Search of Vicinity of Tujunga Pass, Browne's Deputies Fail to Discover Former Boss' Whereabouts

With their clothing and the automobile in which they traveled covered with mud and bearing all the evidences of a long and difficult trip, two members of the force of men working under Samuel L. Browne, chief of the bureau of criminal investigation, returned late yesterday from a fruitless search in the mountains for Nick Oswald, who, it is now believed, is necessary before the special grand jury can resume its sessions.

The two officers, James Campbell and Robert Maehl, left Los Angeles early yesterday and took the shortest route to Tujunga pass, where, it was reported, the former ruler in the tenderloin district was seen several days ago. They reached the camp where Oswald, in less disturbing times, made his headquarters during hunting trips. Evidence that the place had recently been occupied was discovered, but no trace of the occupants no trace of that fact was found.

May Be in Los Angeles No information could be vouchsafed at other places visited, and the men returned to Los Angeles. Belief that Oswald is in Los Angeles was expressed yesterday, and efforts to locate his possible hiding place in this city were redoubled. Friends with whom he would be likely to communicate and relatives who had already denied any knowledge of the man's movements were again closely questioned. Nothing of any nature as to Oswald's whereabouts was gained, and the officers are admittedly at sea, grasping at every circumstance in the hope that a clue will develop.

The non-appearance of Oswald lessens the probability that the grand jury will resume its sessions this week. Hark in the form of promises of immunity, it is said, has been thrown out in the hope that the much wanted witness will grasp it, but the assurance must, of course, apply only to the charge of evading a grand jury summons to defeat the ends of justice.

There still remains the perjury indictment, which cannot be easily withdrawn, and this charge, it is believed, is the danger signal warning Oswald to give the neighborhood of the court house a wide berth.

The grand jury will probably meet Monday, with William Lawrence Fetter, Oswald's lieutenant, as the first witness.

ALEXANDER PAYS VISIT TO BROWNE

RUMORS OF SUCCESSION TO BROADHEAD RENEWED

CHIEF OF CRIMINAL BUREAU IS NON-COMMITTAL

Declares Position Has Not Been Offered Him and Thinks It Useless to Discuss Future Policies

A visit yesterday by George Alexander, mayor-elect, to the office of Samuel L. Browne, chief of the bureau of criminal investigation in the district attorney's office, has revived the report that Mr. Browne is slated to fill the vacancy caused by the prospective resignation of Chief of Police Broadhead.

Mr. Browne said he had received no offer of the position as yet, and declined to discuss the matter at length until there was more basis for the report. "I have not been offered the position," he said, "and do not know that such an offer will be made. If the place is tendered to me there will be time enough to determine whether I would care to undertake the duties of that office. No one realizes the responsibilities of a police chief under present conditions more than I do. "Until an offer is made and accepted there is no use in discussing policies. In fact, I do not believe police officers should have policies. There are only two facts a police officer need bother with: First, what is a reasonable construction of the law? Second, what is the fair view of the facts? The first question must be answered by the prosecuting attorney, and the second is the burden of the police officer. "Browne, in my judgment, would make an ideal chief of police," said a man who has closely followed the recent developments in the civic life of Los Angeles. "His supposedly close connection with the district attorney, however, may have the effect of placing him out of the running, the affiliation of the district attorney with what is known as the machine being undisputed."

Aged Rancher Says Unfair Means Were Employed to Marry Him and Obtain His Property

Samuel B. Kuhn, a wealthy rancher of Glendora, entered a Fourth street pawnshop early in October, 1907, to purchase a watch. He emerged an hour later with his promised bride, a woman he had never seen before, leaning lovingly on his arm.

Later he sought to have the marriage annulled by Judge Houser of the superior court, claiming that even the preliminaries to the wedding, which was performed later by Justice Summerfield, were distasteful, and that he had been induced by unfair methods to bestow his name and some valuable property on an almost total stranger. Kuhn is 70 years old. His wife, who is contesting the suit, is many years younger.

"He told me he knew a young and estimable woman who wanted to marry an old man; that he had offered her his hand, but she had declined because he was too young and frivolous," Kuhn said, the woman appeared in the store. Whether or no she was summoned Kuhn did not know. She came, at any rate, and things moved rapidly thereafter.

Kuhn said the woman took him to a Fifth street hotel and engaged a room, which they both occupied. "I walked the door all night," he said, "and next morning was induced to get a marriage license."

Deeds to Glendale property were procured from Kuhn by his wife under duress, according to the husband's statements, and these he asks the court to set aside. The trial will be resumed this morning.
