Story of Robbery Told. "When the window was pried open Hatfield and Sundin assisted me to get inside," continued Beatty, "and, with the aid of the combination given me by Martin, I opened the two inner doors of the vault and burglar proof chest, took all the currency and gold, leaving only a torn \$1 bill and the silver. The money and tools were given to Hatfield and Sundin after I locked the safe, following Martin's instructions to leave everything in such a way that suspicion would be deflected against some person employed by the bank."
