

MOORE RATE IS AT RECORD MARK

HIGHEST PRICE OF YEAR IS QUOTED ON WALL STREET DULLNESS IN STOCK TRADING DUE TO THIS FACTOR

Commonly Assumed That Speculative Campaign of Last Year Was Largely Due to U. S. Steel

NEW YORK, Dec. 22.—The extreme dullness in stock trading today was traceable to the restraining influence of the tightness of the call money market.

The call loan rate touched the highest of the year, and large amounts were placed at the higher rates.

It is commonly assumed in stock market circles that the great speculative campaign of the last year, while abetted by all the most powerful capitalistic groups, has been most largely entered into by the group centering in U. S. Steel.

A rise in money rates at this time would be of more direct benefit to this group, in such circumstances that would an extension of the upward movement of prices of stocks.

There was another revival of the copper merger story and that group of industrialists showed the effect temporary. None of the "A" influences proved permanent in their effect.
