Philosophy of Saw Filing.

The editor of Health and Home

gives this instruction:

The philosopher stating my kind

of a saw in order consists of having

the very points of all the teeth

as perfectly as may be practicable.

When one tooth is only a trifle

longer than the others on either

side, the whole machine carries

nothing. This illustrates the case

precisely in regard to saw teeth

of unequal lengths. When a few

teeth are so much longer than

the others, the points take such

a rank of the wood that the saw

is forced to cut a groove, and the

teeth do not cut a true kerf. This
