It is reported that the up voyage of the Australia was one of the roughest the steamer has ever had on the route. There was no deck promenading and the spray struck the funnel almost every hour.

Albert Griffith, son of Capt. Griffiths, master of the bark Albert, reached San Francisco in somewhat improved health. When the young man left here it was believed that he would be unable to survive the voyage.

Trial of the two Chinese accused of murder of Luna Duguid at Waiakaa plantation, has been concluded at Hilo. One defendant was acquitted. The other was convicted of manslaughter in the second degree. Chas. Creighton was attorney for the men.

At an upset price of \$23,465.62 the steamship City of Columbia, with her engines, etc., complete, will be offered at auction at noon today in front of the police station by Marshal Brown from an order of the Circuit Court, First Judicial Circuit, in admiralty.
