### A NEW TELEPHONE

#### A Portable Instrument Adopted by Railway.

An Outfit on Each Train—Mishap Can be Reported at Once. Up to Date.

One of the new improvements introduced by the O. R. & L. Co. is the portable telephone. This is an arrangement which may be carried on every train. By throwing a wire over the telephone line and connecting it with the machine and another with the ground, communication is at once established. One of these will be carried on every train that goes out. The conductors will be required to test them every day to ascertain whether they are in good working order. These instruments are carried by few of the roads in the States. The reason for this is that nearly all the lines of communication paralleling the roads are telegraph. Consequently as there are few of the regular attaches of a train who are telegraphers such a machine would be useless. They are especially valuable in the case of accident. By this means the office is at once informed as to the nature of the disaster and where it occurred. This is another incident which shows that the O. R. & L. Co. is keeping abreast of the times

#### MRS. PARKER.

#### Death of a Prominent Woman Known Here.

Mrs. Frances Stuart Parker, the wife of Col. F. W. Parker, of the Cooke County Normal School, died at Chicago on the 1st of April.

Mrs. Parker will be remembered here as having given a course of lectures at Progress Hall last summer. She made many friends while here who were shocked to hear the sad news. She was born in Boston, where she became well known through her connection with educational work. She was one of the leading exponents of Debs' doctrine of the country. During recent years she advocated dress reform, being a co-worker with Jenness Miller. She possessed a trained and pleasing voice and was an able lecturer. At the time of her death she was a prominent member of Educational Societies and Women's Leagues.

#### Dobb's Dream.

In one of the flash papers of the east is a story of Honolulu accredited to "Henry Dobb's, a commercial traveler." There is also a full-page illustration for the yarn. Mr. Dobb's recital is to the effect that while visiting Honolulu he was invited to attend an auction sale of "Japanese bric-a-brac." The man continues that going with friends he saw Japanese girls sold to the highest bidders and that the figures were from \$50 to \$200 a piece. Of course the entire story is false. There has visited Honolulu a man of the name of Dobb's. He came from the Northwest and had some queer interviews in Sound papers when he returned to the States.

#### "The Man With the Hoe"

In a note to an attaché of this paper Edwin Markham, the California poet whose "Man With the Hoe" startled the world, says:

"I am gratified to learn that there is in this world a large body of earnest men who are quick to respond to all questions of justice and humanity. These men are the hope of social progress. They are the sea-wall against the tides of anarchy and disorder. I wish you all prosperily in all your ways."

#### Davey's New Sign.

At the counter of the Royal Hawaiian hotel there is an electrical cigar lighter. Above the point of contact for the weeds is a glass disc that lights up when the contrivance is in use. Frank Davey, the photographer, has ornamented this disc with an advertisement. The feature of the notice to all comers is a view of the hotel annex at Waikiki. This view was taken at right, with the building beautifully illuminated. Mr. Davey states that the negative was made in an exposure of two hours.

#### A Labor Conference.

There was a meeting again yesterday on immigration topics between the head of the Government and prominent representatives of the planting interest. No final conclusions were reached, but progress in the direction of preparing the way to insure a plentiful supply of labor was made.

#### Five Committed.

Five of the Kahuku Japanese have been committed for the murder of Choo Fung Wing. They are Ihara, Yamane, Mankichi, Danjro and Fujimoto. They, together with Manzaburo, will also be tried for the murder of Yee Ling Ching. It is not expected that all the cases of the Kahuku riot will be finished before next week.

#### License Case Proceedings—Right of Way.

The Orphanum license matter was up before the Circuit Court yesterday. C. S. Desky petitioned for a writ of mandamus asking the Minister of Interior to grant him a license from the present date to the 31st of December. In reply to Mr. Desky's allegations that the license is exorbitant, discriminating and unconstitutional, the Minister of Interior states that while the allegations may be true the statute calls for a license of \$5 a night.

The demurrer in the case of Kaneohe Ranch Co. vs. Charlotte King, right of way, was argued before Judge Stanley in chambers yesterday. Horsemen and sporting men generally are taking a keen interest in Saturday's match race between the harness horses Violin and Directress.
