ANNOUNCEMENT.

To Patrons of Oahu College: The following excerpt is from Article XXIII of the Statutes of Oahu College: "College Bills. The tuition fee for the Academy is Thirteen Dollars per term; for Punahou School, Eight Dollars per term. Special courses are given at a special rate, according to the nature and amount of instruction. Registration is not complete until the tuition and all other charges are paid. A student whose registration is incomplete is not admitted to regular standing in any class."

On the Treasurer's books are "bad bills" amounting approximately to Twelve Hundred Dollars, made up almost entirely of unpaid Tuition, Board and Supply accounts. In order that this irregularity may stop at once, Oahu College, like other Institutions of its grade and character, will hereafter do business on a cash basis. Beginning with the Spring Term, April 8, 1901, the above statutory regulation will be rigidly enforced. All students, regular and special, in the Academy and Punahou School will pay tuition and other regular charges before beginning the Term's work. Board bills at Punahou are payable monthly, in advance. In case of continued absence a corresponding rebate will be made. Respectfully, TRUSTEES OF OAHU COLLEGE. By A. M. SMITH, President.




