### A MENACE TO HEALTH

#### Sewage Flume From Hospital for Incurables.

#### PATRONS OF ALA MOANA PROTEST

#### Natives Gather Shell Fish Where Deadly Germs of Consumption Empty Into Sea

Many complaints have been received at the Health Department against the condition of certain portions of the Hospital for Incurables. Fred. W. Macfarlane, president of the Union Feed Company, objects strongly to a flush flume which runs from the hospital to the sea, which also obstructs the roadway along the beach. This flume is used to run off all manner of fluids from the hospital, the nature of which is claimed to be a menace to the health of those who go near it.

As the Hospital for Incurables contains a large number of consumptives in the last stages of the dread disease, and the flume is used for carrying away refuse of all kinds which is affected by the germs of the malady, those who have to make use of the driveway which the Government has endeavored to make one of the charming boulevards of the city, are loud in their protests that this condition of affairs be allowed to exist.

A letter from Mr. Macfarlane to Executive Officer Pratt was read by the Board of Health meeting yesterday afternoon in which he set forth the principal objections to the flume, and gave information of a character which brought the Board to take action at once to mitigate the evil. He stated that where the flume empties into the ocean children were in the habit of gathering shellfish. It was intimated to the Board by Dr. Pratt that those who frequented the shore at that point were in danger of becoming affected from the contents of the flume. The Board of Health, upon the motion of Mr. Mott-Smith, requested City Sanitary Officer Tracy to make a special report of the hospital and the manner in which its refuse was treated or carried away. Mr. Macfarlane's letter, dated yesterday, was as follows:

"I have this day addressed a communication to the Superintendent of Public Works, James H. Boyd, asking that steps be at once taken by him for the removal of the sewerage flume at Kaakao belonging to the Hospital for Incurables. This flume, as you know, runs across the beach roadway, connecting with Ala Moana, and obstructs public traffic. The flume is an open one and takes sewage from the hospital and empties it into the sea, a short distance from the beach where natives are daily seen catching shellfish.

"I feel certain that you will agree with me from a sanitary point of view that such an arrangement is a menace to public health, and therefore I would most respectfully appeal to you to bring this matter before your honorable Board and have the nuisance corrected at once."

#### The Sewer Leakage.

Vincent & Belsler, speaking of the statement that a leakage of forty gallons a minute indicates that something is wrong with the sewer, say that such a leakage is abnormally low. Engineer Hering wrote the Public Works Department some months ago that a leakage of 100 gallons a minute was common and that if the contractors got the figures below that here they would do well. Vincent & Belsler feel well satisfied with the present showing.

### METEOROLOGICAL SUMMARY FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE

Temperature mean for the month, 77.4 F.; normal, 75.9; average daily maximum, 83.7; average daily minimum, 71.9; average daily range, 11.8; greatest daily range, 16 degrees; least daily range, 8 degrees; highest temperature, 86 degrees; lowest, 67. Barometer average, 29.976; normal, 30.012 (corrected for gravity by -.06); highest, 30.11, on the 7th; lowest, 29.85, on the 10th; greatest 24-hour change, .09. "Lows" passed this point on the 5th, 10th, 20th and 29th; "highs" on the 2d, 17th and 23d. The continued low pressure may indicate heavy rains for the fall and winter months.

Relative humidity, 71.5; normal, 70.6; mean dew-point, 67.4; normal, 65.3; mean absolute moisture, 7.35 grains to the cubic foot; normal, 6.83. The absolute humidity was the highest on record for the month of June.

Rainfall, 1.42 inches; normal, 1.52 inches; rain record days, 18; normal, 19; greatest rainfall in one day, 0.41, 23d; total at Luakaha, 8.59; at Kapiolani Park, — Total rainfall since January 1, 22.94 inches; normal, 18.82.

The artesian well level on the 15th of June, stood at 32.55 feet above mean sea level. This is as low as the lowest on record.

Trade wind days, 22 (0 of N.N.E.); normal for June, 26. Average force of wind, Beaufort scale, 2.4 (15 st. miles per hour). There was an unusual spell of eight days of southerly wind from the 6th to the 13th. Cloudiness, tenths of sky, 4.2; normal, 4.0.

Percentages of district rainfall as compared with normal: Hilo, 35 per cent; Hamakua, 10; Kohala, 22; Waimea, 27; Kona, 130; Kau, 150; Puna, 80; Maui, uncertain on account of frequent changes in stations, probably 125 on southeast exposures and 80 on north exposures; Oahu, 100 per cent; Kauai, 100, excepting Hanalei, 75. Northerly exposures suffered as in May. At Waimea, Hawaii, the main stream is lower than ever known before, owing to the denudation of Kohala mountain forest destroying the natural reservoirs.

Mean temperatures: Pepeekeo, Hilo district, 100 feet elevation, average maximum 78.6, average minimum 68.9; Waimea, Hawaii, 2,730 elevation, 77.2 and 65.2; Kohala, 521 elevation, 81.4 and 70.6; Ewa Mill, Oahu, 50 elevation, 86.7 and 69.1; Kulaokaha (W. R. Castle's), 60 feet elevation, highest 87, lowest 67, mean 77.4. The average fall in temperature is one degree F. for each 200 feet of ascent.

Earthquake reported from Kona and Kau on the 8th; not from Hilo. Snow is still visible on summit of Mauna Kea. Kilauea exhibits heat symptoms. Heavy swell 4th and 24th; very smooth sea 6th to 15th. No thunder nor lightning.
