In a free-for-all pace at the Grosse Pointe track, Detroit, Coney went the fastest mile ever traveled in a contest in Detroit, going the distance in 2:02, which is three-fourths of a second better than the gelding's previous record.

The time by quarters was 29 3/4, 1:00, 1:31 1/4, 2:02. In the second heat Coney and Anaconda raced to the quarter in 29 seconds flat. Then Coney broke and Anaconda shot ahead alone.

BY AUTHORITY.

Act 4

AN ACT MAKING SPECIAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENTAL USE OF THE TERRITORY DURING THE TWO YEARS WHICH WILL END WITH THE THIRTIETH DAY OF JUNE, A. D. 1903.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. The following sums amounting to Three Million Five Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Thirty and 52-100 (\$3,523,530.52) Dollars are hereby appropriated to be paid out of all moneys in the Treasury received from all the current receipts of the general revenue of the Territory for the biennial fiscal period commencing with the First day of July, 1901, and ending with the Thirtieth day of June, A. D. 1903.
