Naone, Bitting appearing for the defendant. He had been rather free with objections to questions asked by the plaintiff, and finally when one was put to a witness his objection was made and argued at length.

George Faris will be allowed a continuance in his trial for murder in order that depositions as to his character may be taken in California.
