NUUANU BRIDGE IS TO WAIT

As soon as the concrete piers for the Nuuanu street bridge are completed, work on the structure will be shut down on account of the exhaustion of the funds for roads and bridges.

This bridge, which will stand at an angle of nearly 45 degrees to the stream over which it is being placed, is to be of stone, steel and concrete.

There was appropriated for roads and bridges, Fourth District, by the last legislature, \$150,000, but when Superintendent Cooper came into office, with seven months of the period yet to run, the fund had dwindled to a few thousand dollars.

As soon as the legislature meets an emergency appropriation, to be available at once, will be asked for the purpose of completing the Nuuanu bridge and dredging the harbor.

STREET RAILWAY DEAL NOT OFF

Negotiations looking to the completion of the merger of the Tramways and the Rapid Transit Companies are progressing and there has occurred no hitch which might indicate that there was any danger of a falling through of the deal.
