BERREY'S COMMERCIAL REPORT

Honolulu, Dec. 31, 1904.

The sight of a new year is a pleasing one to most of the business men of the Territory. The big calendar period just ending has been unsatisfactory in many important respects. There were too clearly defined the operations of the great readjustment. This is about ended, however, and with sugar prosperity so certain, 1905 should be a decidedly prosperous year.

December has been the liveliest month for years in the sugar stock market. Trading in the best securities has been heavy. The most significant and gratifying fact in this connection is that large blocks of such stocks as Ewa and Pioneer have been sold by San Francisco people to Honolulu capitalists.

There is very little doing in real estate. Mrs. L. M. Lemmon of collection fame, reported to have sold out and Mr. H. T. Moore has become manager of the Merchants' Protective Agency.

The Rapid Transit Company is to cut off two cars by carrying the Wilder Avenue line into Fort street and the Beretania street line into a junction with the Hotel street line in front of the Drill shed. Puna plantation of 11,000 acres, no mill, is to be sold by court order on February 25.

There have been fifty-four failures in the Territory during 1904. The mortgage indebtedness for the past year shows an increase over releases of \$846,317.91. The mortgage indebtedness has increased since our last report \$ 3,500 15



FULL INDEXING MADE OF THE ORGANIC ACT

The act passed by Congress creating a government for Hawaii repeals and amends scores of civil and criminal statutes previously enacted by Hawaiian legislatures.

No man knows what is in the Organic Act except through the medium of an index. The previously printed copies of this law in use in Hawaii contain only 657 indexed subjects.

The index of the Organic Act in the "Fundamental Law of Hawaii" contains 1399 indexed subjects and cross references.

REPEALED LAWS NOT HERETOFORE INDEXED.

Some of the Hawaiian Statutes repealed by the Organic Act, which are not indexed in the previous publication, but which are fully indexed in the Fundamental Law of Hawaii are as follows:

Jury Law, Maritime Laws. Naturalization, Habeas Corpus, Arrest of Debtors, Garnishment.
