SHARES OF SOME STOCKS TOOK TUMBLE YESTERDAY

Favorites of the Recent Bull Movement Fell a Few Points, But the Market in General Showed Up Firmly.

The stock market, although somewhat firm as to the stocks most prominent in the recent bull movement, at the opening of business hours fell considerably during the morning and late in the afternoon had not recovered to any extent. McBryde went to 10 bid with an offer of 10 1-2. This was a fall of four points from Tuesday's quotations. There was hardly any reason apparent for the slump.

The same thing occurred to Kihai which went to 14, although the last sale recorded stiffened the stock considerably being made at 16. The great demand for the stock for several days has not decreased to any extent, although many prospective buyers were holding off for a possible temporary slump to get in at lower prices.

Ewa failed to oscillate much. A sale of 23 shares was made at the afternoon session of the Exchange at 32 87 1-2. A later bid of 33 was made, on the street.

There were no more offerings of Kahuku and the last sale stands at 34.

Pioneer Mill stands up well in the race, a bid of 150 being made, as against 140 for the sale recorded.

Olaa, since rising to 10, has remained firm at that figure for bids, with 10 1-2 asked. There was little doing in Olaa yesterday. Waiaha dropped slightly, a sale being made of 30 shares at 85.

Wildier S. S. was bid at 115, with 130 asked, although a sale of five shares was made the day before at 140.

Several meetings of sugar companies are to be held in a few days. Among them will be that of Kihai, at which time a statement of the condition of the plantation and its prospects, estimated crop, etc., will be presented.

FIRST "SEEING HONOLULU" COACHING TRIP TODAY

The first of the series of eight coaching trips planned for "seeing Honolulu" will be given this morning. The coach which is to be used will seat twenty-three persons and it promises to have some twenty passengers. The hotel men have taken up the matter in earnest as it offers a pleasant morning to their guests and bookings have been made already for trips which will occur in late February.

The start this morning will be from the Young Hotel at 9:30 o'clock. The Hawaii Promotion Committee rooms in Hotel street will be the next stop for any persons who may wish to make a rendezvous there and the Royal Hawaiian Hotel folk will be picked up next. From that point to the Moana Hotel no stop will be made.

The route will be down Richards street past the Executive Building to King street through which and the Waikiki road the coach will proceed to Kapiolani Park. The Kawaiahaeo church and Seminary, the first wooden house in Honolulu, Thomas Square, the "Old Plantation" and the Government nursery are some of the interesting things seeable on the first named street.

Along the Waikiki road on Sunny South, the Hawaiian Hotel Annex, formerly the seaside residence of King Kamehameha III, and IV. Opposite the Moana Hotel is the entrance to Anahan, residence of the late Princess Kaiulani, and near are the residences of Prince Kuhio, Delegate to Congress, and the seaside place of former Queen Liliuokalani. Through Kapiolani, passing the aquarium and some of the finest residences of the city, the route will lie to the Diamond Head road. Passing the lighthouse there will open the view of the low-lying southern island of Molokai and on the clearest days it is often possible to see the islands of Lanai



and Maui far off to the south. Toward the eastern side of the old crater, Koko Head, the beautiful stretch of Waialae Bay, with its fringe of coconut trees, lies at one's feet.

The return to the park around the Diamond Head road leads past the Victoria Hospital along the Kaimuki suburb. Once more in the Park the road leads past Camp McKinley and through an avenue of date palms back to the Waikiki road, whence the return is made.
