BROKE RECORD FOR WIRELESS

KENTWELL RESPONDENT His Brother-in-Law G. H. Holt Complains Against Him.

George H. Holt has brought a bill for accounting against Lawrence K. Kentwell. Petitioner sets forth that he "is a ranchman, who has devoted the greater portion of his life to pastoral pursuits and who has little knowledge of any other business than the raising of cattle, while respondent is a resident of Honolulu, and is a keen and sharp business man and is especially conversant and familiar with the real estate business in Honolulu.

The Honolulu property consists chiefly of an undivided one-half interest in a valuable piece of land at the corner of Maunakea and Pauahi streets, the other half being owned by Annie Holt Kentwell, wife of respondent and sister of petitioner.

When Kentwell took charge of it, the property was subject to a lease made to Lee Wai for 15 years from Sept. 1, 1894. Lee Wai had made valuable improvements upon the leasehold, which by various conveyances was transferred to Caterina A. Wright and she sold it, at the first of June, 1900, to Kentwell acting as agent for Kananimauloa, Annie Holt and petitioner, and here comes the first charge made against Kentwell, to wit:

Subsequent demands by petitioner for an accounting of the rents or profits were denied by respondent, who maintained that he was entitled to keep them as owner of the leasehold. Petitioner, on information and belief, alleges that respondent bought the leasehold with money belonging to his cestui que trustant.

Next petitioner alleges that respondent made a bill of sale to Ching Kok, purporting to convey to him an interest in the premises for a consideration of \$1000, and that although demand has been made on respondent he has not accounted for petitioner's interest in said sum.
