## AFTERMATH OF BATTLE

### The Talk of a Dark Horse for Sheriff Growing.

Of course, while the Republican Precinct Club elections carried victory for Brown over Crabbe in the fight for the shrievalty of Oahu, it was so little decisive that the opposition showed no signs of let-up yesterday. Brown, with the assistance of the Harris, Lucas and Sam Johnson strength, the strength of the men who are opposing Achi for Supervisor-at-Large, has shown that he is stronger than Crabbe. That is all.

It is said, among the Democrats and Home Rulers, that Charlie Notley, erstwhile leader of the Home Rulers, is out of politics. It is said that he is even out of Oahu—or will be. 
