Frank L. Webster, manager of the new rubber plantation in Puna, returned yesterday by the Claudine to Hawaii. The company now has about twelve thousand trees planted out. It has a tract of about 1800 acres of land of which about 500 is suitable for rubber. Mr. Webster says that the prospects of the plantation are most flattering.
