If the plans projected by T. H. Petrie, the manager of this year's Floral Parade, go through, Honolulu will be treated to a military demonstration in which the Infantry, Cavalry, Marines and the National Guard will take part, making a parade greater than any which has been and something which will be as great a sight for the kamainas as for the tourists and newcomers.

McCandless was named to head the finance committee, whose work will be of the greatest importance and upon which depends in a great measure the success of the work of all the other committees. Mr. McCandless will commence rustling at once.

Automobile owners are each expected to do their duty; horsemen are being depended upon to be in the line, in surry, trap or saddle, while the floats this year, with the experience of other years to guide the designers, ought to be more and better than ever before.
