


NEWS OF THE WATERFRONT

SHERIDAN WILL SAIL TOMORROW

Nippon Maru Due at Noon-- Ship Falls of Clyde Outside the Harbor.

Carrying what is probably the heaviest list of troops that any transport has taken through this port during the past year, the U. S. A. T. Sheridan, Captain Babcock, arrived here from San Francisco yesterday afternoon early and will continue her voyage to Guam and the Philippines tomorrow afternoon at three o'clock.

Head signal station called up last night after dark to state that the Associated Oil Company's ship Falls of Clyde was directly off the head and was steering for Honolulu, where she would anchor outside for the night.

Nippon Here Today.

Wireless word was received from the Toyo Kisen Kaisha liner Nippon Maru yesterday to the effect that she would arrive here at noon today from the Orient.

Shipping Notes.

The Matson steamer Hilonian moved over to the Oceanic wharf yesterday to discharge her cargo, thereby making room for the Hyades to dock at the Matson wharf.

It was stated yesterday in these columns that the S. C. Allen sailed from San Francisco for this port. This was a mistake, as the schooner sailed from Eureka.
