

In response to a request of Governor Frear for a report on the work done in the Court of Land Registration during the past year, Judge Robinson submitted the following statement yesterday:

Number of petitions filed, 7.  
Number of cases disposed of, 14.  
Area of land registered, 1646 and 676-1000 acres.

Value of land registered, \$106,985.  
For the year July 1, 1908, to June 30, 1909, the number of petitions filed was 22, cases disposed of 25, the area 56 and 264-1000 acres and value of land registered \$133,620.

The number of cases still pending is fifteen.
