KISSING.
 It is Neither Dangerous Nor Disagreeable.

Sometime ago a portion of the Medical fraternity of the Hawaiian Islands met. The doctors who had indulged in a rather heavy dinner the night before—were "down" on kissing. Dr. Emerson considered it a most dangerous and pernicious habit and the other doctors agreed with him. (None of the young doctors were around except one who was "too young.") For the purpose of assisting the learned sons of Aesculapius an opinion on kissing given by a high authority is printed below:

An Englishman has just advanced a theory in a medical journal that will be hailed with delight by at least the younger generation of this country and probably by the youth of all the world. He has delivered a scientific opinion to the effect that kissing, once the object of much medical disrepute, is an altogether wholesome and healthy exercise; that it is not the dangerous practice which it has of late been painted, and that, instead of being avoided as being fraught with bacteriological menace, it is to be encouraged as one of the best of all exercises for the human system. This may be putting it a little strong, and, perhaps, stronger than the scientific gentleman intends that his opinions should be taken, but it is cheering, nevertheless. It was a deadly blow that was levelled at the art of osculation when the medical world declared that kissing from lip to lip tended to introduce into either one of the two systems that were thus engaged—and sometimes not engaged—new forms of animal life that were deleterious to health. One or other of the kissers were supposed to be always fairly teeming with bacteria. To kiss meant sure, though, perhaps, slow death. A shudder ran through the amative, sentimental world, and the market rate of kisses fell with a thud. Hitherto affectionate couples became distant, preserving a radius of microbial safety, as it were. When fears were overcome, and surreptitious kisses taken, the apprehension lingered that a great danger had been faced. It cannot be denied that the average kiss grew shorter in duration and diminished in frequency. But the latest scientific opinion has probably checked the tendency to sidetrack the kiss. This opinion is to the effect that in the kissing persons encounter only the beneficent organisms, and that the advantages of kissing far outweigh its infinitesimal risk.

Court Notes.
 In Annette Freimann vs. P. G. Camarinos and Geo. Lycurgus demurrer has been filed. Petition for probate of A. McIntyre's will has been filed and temporary letters of administration granted to L. A. Thurston and A. F. P. McIntyre. The estate consists of homestead valued at \$4000 and personal property \$3250. The final account of S. K. Aki in the estate of Naholowaa is on file. Defendant's demurrer in the case of W. Kalaeao vs. W. C. Achi and Lam Achi is on file. Application has been made by guardian to sell real estate in the matter of Robert Lapaela Fuller, a minor. Ohera vs. Ackerman, a bill in equity for specific performance, was heard and submitted. An order appointing G. A. Davis attorney of record in place of Judge Davidson, in J. R. Silva vs. J. W. Kuaimoku, has been made. J. A. Magoon makes affidavit in the Medeiros bankruptcy. The answer of Manuel Bronco in the matter of C. Bosse, assignee, vs. M. Bronco and J. A. Affonso to set aside a mortgage, is on file. Defendants have answered in A. S. Cleghorn vs. Sun Wo. Co. and Wong Sing Wai Co., ejectment. Papers in re fencing dispute between J. P. Mendonca and Wong Kwai in Kailua have been filed.
