"There are commercial interests in Chicago representing several million dollars of capital which have for six months past been considering permanent investments in the Hawaiian Islands. These investments would have been made last summer if the permanency of the Dole Government could have been assured. This assurance could not be given, owing to the fact announced by President Dole and his friends that, although their request for annexation had once been refused by the United States, they intended to renew it as soon as a new administration came into power."

The only thing noticeable is that the Advertiser dares to hint that there is no assurance of the permanency of the Dole Government. What are we coming to?

It is a fact that the Bulletin has charged us with inconsistency towards the Board of Health in its treatment of our recent epidemic. Nay more it even tried to make out that we used it as political capital. And that we first denied it was Asiatic cholera and hounded down the other papers (thereby presumably meaning it) for raising a scare. Also that we further said it was Asiatic cholera. Now we have never yet expressed an opinion as to the form of the disease or its name. In anything in that way we have simply taken the statements of the most reliable medicine men that the Board could find. Now, however, after the epidemic seems to have died out, the Bulletin editorially endorses Dr. Surmann's opinion that the disease was not Asiatic cholera. Yet no paper did more to cause scare amongst the public, while the disease was in our midst, than the Bulletin, and always with the statement—Asiatic cholera. Our action was consistent. We didn't care what the disease was. It was among us. It was fatal. We simply praised the Board of Health for what it did do, and asked its members to resign because under their regime it had made its appearance, and it seemed—and still does seem—that they were responsible for its having appeared, owing to their political views having induced them to neglect to keep their employees up to the strict mark of that vigilant duty which ought to be the standard of a Board of Health.
