apply to livery, hack, bus, teamcar, truck, express, dairy and all other stables where five or more horses or mules are kept.

REGARDING GARBAGE.

Sec. [22]. No garbage, stable manure, night soil or animal or vegetable refuse of any nature which is dangerous to the public health shall be used for grading purposes, or for filling up any house lot or other tract of land.

Sec. [23]. Any person violating any of the foregoing regulations shall be punished as provided by law.

AMENDMENT TO REGULATIONS REGARDING THE INTERMENT OF THE DEAD IN THE DISTRICT OF HONOLULU, ISLAND OF OAHU.

At a meeting of the Board of Health held on the 11th day of January, 1901, the regulations regarding the interment of the dead in the District of Honolulu was amended by adding thereto the words, "and not to the owners of such plots, to the jeopardy of the public health," so that said regulations shall read as follows:

"Resolved, That no permit for interments shall be granted within the city limits except to those already possessing burial plots, and not to the owners of such plots, to the jeopardy of the public health."
