NEWSPAPER NOMENCLATURE.

A Quarter of Our Periodicals Classified Under Ten Titles.

The study of the 1,500 packed pages of an American newspaper directory reveals much that is interesting and amusing, and not a little that possesses importance.

Not that the great majority of periodicals in the United States do not bear rational and business-like names; they do. Fully a quarter of them are to be classed under ten titles.

It is not easy to account for local fashions in newspaper nomenclature. Kansas has only seven Tribunes; young Dakota, with a quarter of her population, has as many.
