How, in Early Times, Plain John Smith Became "Maister" and His Wife "Mistress" - Corruption of the Once Honored Term.

[Home Journal.] Not only in our country, but apparently with all modern peoples, the habit has arisen and become a permanent one every day...

In the earlier times of our history the ordinary man was simply William or John; that is to say, he had merely a Christian name, without any kind of "handle" before it or surname after it.

For a long series of years, however, no one was called "Maister," or "Master" (into which "Maister" got transformed), unless he was distinctly in a position superior to that of the great bulk of his fellow-countrymen...

We find an example of the old use of the word still surviving in official ranking immediately below that of the 17th century, and it is occasionally grating to a stranger to hear a grave and gray-haired gentleman referred to as Master Jones.

Not only, however, was John Smith's wife known as Mistress Smith, but his grown-up, unmarried daughters were equally called Misses, with the addition of their Christian names, for distinction's sake.

As to the derivation of the word "Miss," it seems clear that it is not obtained by curtailing "Mistress" of its last syllable, but rather has arisen from the custom of abbreviating that word into Miss.
