

One of the New British Ironclads. Six war vessels have just been completed for the British navy. They are called the "Admiral" ships from being named for famous admirals.

The Benbow is, however, the most notable vessel of her class in the British navy. She is different from others in that she carries the two most powerful naval guns in the world. They are 110-ton breech-loading cannons. They are 43 1/2 feet long, and fire an 1,800-pound ball.



The Benbow cannon is more powerful than the famous Krupp 110-ton gun. That weapon fired with a muzzle energy of 46,061 foot tons. The Benbow's gun has a muzzle energy of 61,300 foot tons. It is calculated that it will pierce a wrought iron armor plate over thirty inches thick. It is a roarer, no mistake.

Like most of these great guns and great ships, however, the Benbow and her huge cannon are probably more formidable on paper than anywhere else. They are very rarely in lead through to real action. They serve more to impress the public mind than anything else.
