ALMOST DIED IN CHINA

Ex-Secretary of State Dobson Talks About His Experience as a Consul in the Orient

CHINA UNFIT PLACE TO LIVE

Conditions in Most of the Cities are Unbearable and Heat is So Intense as to Make Life Miserable—Filthy Streets Breed Contagious Diseases and Death Rate is Terrible.

Des Moines, Nov. 11.—Hon. George L. Dobson, ex-secretary of state and recent American consul to Hangchow, China, who arrived in Des Moines Friday after the long journey from China, believes his health has been seriously injured, if not permanently, by his residence in the Orient. Mr. Dobson was carried on board the steamer Mongolia when he sailed from Shanghai, he was ill on the voyage home, was seriously sick while making the trip from San Francisco to Des Moines, and is in a critical condition just now, so critical that his relatives and friends are very much worried.

"I can only say that I am far from a well man," said Mr. Dobson when seen at the Elliott hotel last evening. "I am naturally a little anxious about my condition. Yes, I believe my falling health is due entirely to my residence in China. I began to fall as soon as I got there. Had malaria, chills and later a severe attack of the Dengue fever, which is similar to the jungle fever in India."

Before Mr. Dobson left China he consulted physicians who said he was afflicted with Bright's disease and must leave China at once. He lost thirty pounds while he was absent from this country, and looks thin and weak. He will consult physicians here at once as to his physical condition.

"I have nothing to say in regard to my public position while abroad," said Mr. Dobson, "until I see my report in this country, which will be within the next few days. I will say, what I have said publicly, that China is not entitled to the consideration of civilized nations. In her present condition she is hardly worth a place on the map."

"As to the boycott of American goods by the Chinese, I now stand in abeyance and will until after action is taken at Washington on the proposed treaty. Chinese officials and gentry are not so much opposed to the United States' action in keeping coolie labor out of the country, as they are to the fact that China is singled out and branded among nations."

"They believe, and I believe with them, that there is another solution of the question, that there should be some educational test by which the coolie labor of all countries could be brought under the new proposition. As for myself, I think the coolie labor of Japan is quite as objectionable as that of China or other eastern countries."

"I saw nothing about China during my short residence there that would attract any human being there for a permanent home. I don't see how for a person could care to go to China and live in any city, outside of perhaps one or two places."

"Males Would Bar Report." "In most of the cities conditions are unbearable. If I were to report things to the United States government exactly as I saw them, the report would not go through the mails."

"Think of street so narrow that you can't stand in the center and touch the walls either side with your hands. Imagine this street teeming with people while the thermometer was 110 in the shade and 95 at midnight. All of the street, looking out of the fifth which is allowed to be deposited there, and you can imagine why there was so much cholera in China this summer."

"Hogs, many dogs which were barely alive and with their feet in the dirt, by disease, chickens, etc., ran the streets along with the people, and in some of the thoroughfares of the largest cities. Lepers at large, too. I tell you the condition there is simply beyond comprehension unless you see it."

"Chinese dropped dead by hundreds of strokes on the streets of Hangchow this summer. I saw them carried off by the dozens. I have seen five coffins go by in twenty minutes. I saw a few of the Chinese exult under the conditions which prevail there."

"I found Mr. Conger universally liked. There are a few grafters who are opposed to him, but their opposition is very slight."

"I do not know what my future plans will be. I have nothing in mind as yet. For the present, I propose to devote my time to regaining my health. I have nothing to say about politics. Mrs. Dobson is as vehement as her husband in denouncing the unsanitary surroundings and disagreeable conditions which exist in China."

"We didn't like it at all," she said. "Most of the conditions are too filthy to talk about. Some of the natives there are more like cattle or monkeys than human beings with brains to reason with. A great many of them, who are not so much opposed to the United States' action in keeping coolie labor out of their waists or upper part of the body, and some of the women also, not so many; and there are plenty of children there that never have a rag of clothing."

"We had to boil every bit of water we used and could not eat any uncooked vegetables for fear of cholera, which was very bad there. The natives died by the hundreds this summer. We didn't like it at all."

"About the same distance from us was a leper hospital, and these poor creatures were running at large. We walked down past it one day and they were a dreadfully repulsive sight. One old man was blind with his nose eaten away. Another had his fingers nearly all gone; another his toes, the remnants of which were bleeding. There were many other sights quite as revolting."

"We heard of a summer resort in the mountain thru missionaries, after we had suffered terrifically from the heat at Hangchow, so we went there. RAILROADS PAY LITTLE

The Big Drainage Ditch in Western Iowa Will Cost Railways Only Small Sum

WHERE LAW NEEDS CHANGING

Railways Will Receive Great Benefit By Reason of Construction of the Ditch, but Their Share of the Taxes Will be Small in Proportion—Superintendents Make Report.

Council Bluffs, Nov. 11.—Out of \$230,165.76 representing the total assessment of benefits for the Pottawattamie and Harrison county joint drainage system, the Illinois Central and Northwestern railroads will together pay only about \$3,000, a trifle over 1 per cent of the whole amount. In reporting this fact to the supervisors' ditch board of the two counties, the three commissioners appointed to make up the schedule of benefits lay the blame upon the Iowa drainage law, which prevents the listing of railway roadbeds except on an acreage basis, the same as farm lands.

The report was filed in the office of Auditor Cheyne in this city yesterday, and a copy of it given to Auditor Atkins at Logan. The Northwestern's assessment in Harrison county is shown to be \$981.46, which includes the Sioux City & Pacific line of Missouri Valley, while in Pottawattamie the assessment comes only to \$267.83. This is a total of \$1,249.09 for both counties, but it is stated that this does not include town lots belonging to the Northwestern at Missouri Valley, which will raise the amount by several hundred dollars. The Illinois Central is assessed at \$1,019.57 in Pottawattamie and \$587.79 in Harrison, a total of \$1,607.36.

When the drainage board was awarding damages to property owners, it allowed the Northwestern \$35,000 to pay for four bridges which the road will have to build because of the ditches to be constructed across its right of way. Deducting its assessment, estimated at \$1,750, from this sum, there is left the comfortable balance of \$33,250 to insure the railroad company against any loss. By economizing on its bridge material, it can doubtless make good the small assessment levied against it, so that the net result of the law contributed nothing toward the ditch.

Des Moines Concern Will Bring An Action Against Franklin County. Special to Times-Republican. Hampton, Nov. 11.—The board of supervisors at their meeting refused to allow the claim of the Marsh Creek Co. against the county for \$580 for damages claimed by the company for not being allowed to put in a cement bridge over the Squaw creek entrance to Hillsdale cemetery. Suit will probably be brought against the county by the bridge company, though County Attorney Mallory has instructed the clerk that the county will not be liable for the claim. The bridge was to have been constructed under the supervision of Supervisor Henderson and he decided they were too late to do the work this fall.

TO BUILD NEW BRIDGE. Iron Structure Will Span North Skunk River in Mahaska. Special to Times-Republican. Oskaloosa, Nov. 11.—The board of supervisors of Mahaska county yesterday decided to construct a large iron bridge across North Skunk river. The contract was let to the George E. King Bridge Co., of Des Moines, for \$2,500. The bridge will be located about two miles above Union mill and will cross the river in such a way that people in that district. A site has been chosen with high banks on each side, where it is said water has never been known to reach a point high enough to endanger the bridge.

Work on the structure will be started in the near future.
