TRADES UNIONS JOIN IN MOVEMENT TO HELP STRIKING 'PHONE OPERATORS.

GENERAL GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE NAMED

Member From Each Union Represented at the Meeting Placed on the Committee That Will See Telephone Company Managers on Behalf of the Girls—W. T. Dooley Chairman.

At a rousing meeting of the different union labor organizations of the city, held at the Marshalltown Trades and Labor Assembly hall Thursday night, the movement to espouse the cause of the striking telephone operators of the city was formally launched.

A press committee was also chosen by the unions, to keep the newspapers posted on the strike situation from the girls' viewpoint.

The sixteen unions which are interested with the girls' organization in an effort to bring about a settlement of the strike are as follows: Musicians, boilermakers, helpers, machinists' helpers, barbers, blacksmiths, electrical workers, car workers, boilermakers, painters, plumbers, molders, carpenters, machinists, cigarmakers, bartenders, and printers.

BUSINESS WILL NOT SUSPEND TOMORROW

NEW LEGAL HOLIDAY WILL ONLY BE OBSERVED BY THE SALOONS.

POSTOFFICE, BANKS, AND LIBRARY OPEN

Government Issues No Information to Postoffice as to Observance, and Regular Business Hours Will Be Observed—Town Will Be Dry, However, Until Monday.

The saloonists of the city are the only people who will observe Lincoln's birthday as a legal holiday, Saturday. It is not because the saloon men care anything for Lincoln, or his memory, but because they will take no chances on remaining open on a holiday, even tho there has been some question as to the intent of the law in declaring Feb. 12 as a permanent legal holiday in Iowa.

At Waterloo a new arrangement is to be put into effect on Lincoln's birthday. The day will be observed as a legal holiday by the postoffice and banks, but the postoffice, instead of having the carriers' windows open at certain hours, as heretofore on holidays, a delivery will be made through the entire city in the morning.

Attorney General Says Holiday. There has been a question as to what was intended when the legislature, at its last session, declared Feb. 12 to be a legal holiday in Iowa. By some the act was construed to make the day a legal holiday for last year only, because of Lincoln's centennial.
