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WARREN G. PURDY DEAD.

Former Head of Rock Island Railroad Victim of Old Injury.

Chicago, Oct. 14.—Warren G. Purdy, former president of the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific railroad, died at 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon from an illness which eight years ago caused him to resign his high office. His death occurred in his home, 4819 Lake avenue, which he had not been able to leave during the last six months.

Mr. Purdy's illness is believed to have been the result of an injury received in a wreck in 1900. Mr. Purdy was a passenger on a Northern Pacific train which was turned over by a hurricane. He suffered a concussion of the spine and his nervous system was so affected that he was compelled to retire from active work two years later. The affection steadily became more serious, finally causing confinement to his bed.

Mr. Purdy was one of the great railroad builders of the central west, and has been named among the country's great financiers. Fifty-nine years old at the time of his retirement, he had risen from the position of office boy to be the head of a great railroad system.
