REV. J. H. NIBLOCK DIES AT MILWAUKEE

FORMER PASTOR OF UNITED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH SUCCESSORS TO LONG ILLNESS.

WAS FATHER OF MRS. CHARLES C. TRINE, OF THIS CITY

End Comes in Milwaukee Hospital Wednesday Evening—Body Will Be Taken to Oshkosh, Wis., For Burial

Death Wednesday evening, in Lakeside hospital, Milwaukee, of Rev. John H. Niblock, for several years a resident of this city, and father of Mrs. Charles C. Trine, 203 West State street.

Sketch of Mr. Niblock's Career. Rev. John Howard Niblock was a son of Rev. Dr. Isaac Niblock, who immediately after graduating from Edinburgh University, Edinburgh, Scotland, came to the United States and settled at Butler, Pa.

Served in Civil War. He served for one year in the civil war, going to Oshkosh, Wis., after the war. This was his first pastoral charge, where he ministered for twelve years in the United Presbyterian church.

Pastor Here For Three Years. Mr. Niblock, in 1881, married Mrs. Isabella D. Blessig, who survives him. Mr. Niblock had charge of the Marshalltown United Presbyterian church from 1887 to 1890. He served the church at Cedar Rapids from 1890 to 1894, when his health failed and he again came east to enter Hallman hospital, Chicago, for a severe operation.
