COSSON NOT WORRYING OVER SALINGER'S SUITS

Des Moines, Dec. 9.—The indeterminate sentence and parole system should be, in my estimation, classed as one of the strongest influences we have in reformatory work.


Senator George Cossion, special counsel for the state, is not given to worrying over the effort which is still being made to induce the United States supreme court to suspend the operation of the Iowa prohibitory and mulct laws pending the determination of certain appeals in cases from Boone, Carroll and Marshall counties from the decision of Judge McPherson upholding the Iowa laws.

"The most serious matter that confronts us just now is the danger that President Taft will induce Senator Cummins to accept a place on the supreme bench," said Henry Wallace yesterday.

Creger, of Cherokee, to the department of the judge advocate general, and upon the promotion of Col. C. S. Sharpe of the Twenty-third Infantry to be a brigadier general.

OPPOSE LAKE DRAINAGE

Northern Iowa Sportsmen Indignant Over Project, Obviously of Speculators, to Drain Wall Lake, About Only Body of Water of Any Extent Remaining.

Iowa Falls, Dec. 9.—The announcement that Wall Lake is to be drained is received with righteous indignation among the sportsmen of northern Iowa, who feel that they have not had a square deal, and the pertinent question is asked why the executive council did not notify the opposition to this project of the date of the hearing, in order that some showing might be made as to the rights of the sportsmen.

Wall Lake is about the only body of water of any size left in this part of the state, and, being remote from a city or town, has proven a popular rendezvous for wild fowls, thus offering hunters splendid sport in season.

Sportsmen take the position that the elimination of this lake is desired by only a few speculators, who hope to buy the lake bed from the state for a mere pittance, and then turn the land at a good figure, at the expense of the state taxpayers.

The draining of this lake means that 500 acres of lake bed will become available and will be gobbled up by interested parties, who foresee a nice little fortune when the lake bed is drained.
