MAYOR AND HERMAN MIX WITH WORDS

EXECUTIVE AND COUNCILMAN DO NOT "HIT IT OFF" VERY WELL.

MAYOR ACCUSES HERMAN OF LACK OF "BACK BONE"

Herman Says He Has the "Back Bone," But That He is Not Given Latitude Due His Position—Alleged Violation of Sign Ordinance Brings Up Discussion.

"When is a sign not a sign? When it is not an electric light" is the way Jo Miller would put it in his joke book if he were getting up a revised edition today.

A sign erected by C. W. Sparks contrary, it is claimed, to the city sign ordinance, caused a breach between Mayor Jones and Councilman Herman at the council session today, when Mr. Herman, as superintendent of the department of public safety, was giving his report.

Mr. Herman reported on what he declared to be a sign erected without the approval of the sign inspector, and contrary to the ordinance calling for electric signs, and referred to his efforts to have Mr. Sparks arrested for misdemeanor, but that the mayor "hadn't time" to get out the warrant.

Wordy Battle Follows. This precipitated a wordy battle. The mayor accused Herman of being responsible for the lack of a warrant, for his failure to swear to the information. Herman replied that he was not given any opportunity to swear to anything. The mayor explained that during his absence, he had delegated Mr. Lamb, as acting mayor, to issue the warrant for Sparks, and still Herman had not come forward with the necessary affidavit.

The upshot of it all was that the mayor accused Herman of not having any "back bone" when it came to doing things, also of being negligent in his departments.

Herman retorted with the charge that his powers were so circumscribed by the mayor that he had no rights in his departments. The mayor replied that he had to act because the superintendent refused to, and charged lack of action in the streets department where gas mains had been laid and the streets allowed to remain unsettled for weeks at a stretch.

"If you'll give me my rights in my department," added Herman, "I'll fulfill my duties, and I'll get you in bad too. I was elected by the people the same as you were," continued Herman, "and I had four to fight when you had one and got more votes than you did."

"Yes, you were elected by the people all right, but they think now they made a mistake," replied the mayor. Herman's rejoinder was to "wait until the next election and see."

Warrant is Prepared. Mayor Jones got out his block of warrants and filled in the charge against Mr. Sparks. Herman was to furnish the date of the commission of the alleged misdemeanor and returned with the information that Mr. Sparks had informed him that the sign had not been erected according to his orders, and that he had not paid for the work, and would not until it had been done as ordered. Furthermore, he had contracted with an electrical firm to electrify the sign. With this at hand Mr. Herman decided to give the photographer a few more days in which to comply with the ordinance.
