CONFERENCE AT DES MOINES STEERS CLEAR OF DISCUSSION.

PETITION CONGRESS TO DELAY VOTE ON BILL

Want Shafroth Amendment Kept in Committee Until After Next Convention—New Program Committee to Select Place for Next Meeting—Several Cities Bid for Conference.

Des Moines, March 31.—Final sessions of the Mississippi Valley suffrage conference here today were to be devoted to the consideration of plans for more effective organization in states where the suffrage movement has not shown marked progress.

Delegates from Indiana were active in behalf of Indianapolis early today, while New Orleans and St. Louis adherents were busy. On the conference committee matter the only certainty appeared to be Miss Flora Dunlap, president of the Iowa Suffrage Association, prominent social settlement worker, who is also a member of the Des Moines board of education.
