

LAWMAKERS MAKE GOOD PROGRESS

ADJOURNMENT OF SESSION AT TIME CONTEMPLATED APPEARS PROBABLE.

MORE THAN EIGHTY HOUSE BILLS IN SENATE

Senate Passes More Than Fifty Measures Over to the House—Most of Legislation of Session to Come From That Group—Complete Record of Both Houses to Date.

Des Moines, March 22.—Legislative work the past week has not been greatly encouraging for adjournment at the usual time.

The process that is going on right now is one preliminary to having the legislature abandon and repudiate its proper function of legislation with deliberation and passage of bills on merit.

The house now has more than eighty of its bills over in the senate and the senate has more than fifty of its bills over in the house.

The house passed much the larger number of bills the past week, but nearly all house bills. It is evident the play of the house is to load the senate with its bills and to undertake to force their consideration.

There will be an effort to fight it out by a long and hard struggle and test of endurance.

There may be a setting mad and sudden quitting with no good record for the legislature.

In view of the almost certainty that within a few days the weather will warm up and spring open it is probable the legislators will get restless and anxious to close up.

But it is probable that there will be a breaking away about the middle of next month, the sitting committee having cleared the calendars of much of the important business.
